History

The Wanneroo Cricket Club (WCC) was founded in 1973 and since that time has won more than 33 premierships, including 15 A Grade Premierships (A Grade Premiers in 2014/15) in the North Suburban Community Cricket Association (NSCCA), previously the Wanneroo Cricket Association. The WCC celebrated its 40th anniversary in 2014/15 and continues to have more than 100 Senior playing members and this season will field six teams in the NSCCA Kookaburra league. The WCC also has over 240 Junior playing members.

Home Grounds

The Wanneroo Cricket Club (WCC) and clubrooms are based at the Wanneroo Showgrounds. We run a licenced bar on Thursday and Saturday nights and generally have 50 or more players and associates attend the Saturday night presentations. Registration Fees

Social Events

Apart from normal bar operations on Thursday and Saturday nights the club runs a number of social functions each season plus an end of season Awards dinner. A number of functions are planned for the 2016/17 season including the annual Quiz Night, Ladies High Tea, Christmas Party, WCC Cricketers Cup, Crickter of the Year and the annual season Wind-up.

100 Club

The WCC will be running the 100 Club in the 2016/17 season. The WCC established the 100 club in the 2013/14 season as a means of fundraising and sponsorship. 100 Club membership is \$100 and includes entry, drinks and 100 club prize drawer (for 100 Club members only) at the WCC Cricketers Cup to be held in February 2017 (date to be confirmed).

"The Roos" Social Club Membership

The WCC has introduced "The Roos" Social club membership for the 2016/17 season. "The Roos" Social club membership is available to all non players and the cost is \$30. Membership includes a stubby holder, first drink free, keyring and sticker. You will also receive the regular WCC email update including player, sponsor, news and event details. Team, Captains and Selection

The Club has more than 100 playing members this season. Six teams are fielded in the NSCCA Kookaburra League. Teams, Captains and Vice Captains are to be confirmed.

The Club Senior Coach and Selection Captain is **Craig Kirkby**.

The main criterion for selection is consistent performance on match day. Although this is the main criteria, other factors will be taken in to consideration such as:

- Spirit of the Game – How a player conducts himself on the field whilst representing the club.
- Training – Full training including fielding drills and fitness work twice a week for A/C/D Grades and at least once a week for other grades, however they are encouraged to train twice a week. Players must let their Captain or Selection Captain know in advance if they cannot make training.
- Availability - If unable to commit to the majority of the season in a side then players will be considered for lower grades.
- Financial status - A financial player will be picked ahead of a non-financial player. If payment arrangement is made with the Treasurer, that player will be considered financial.
- Involvement - Support for the club will also be taken into consideration. This includes staying back at the club Thursday and Saturday nights, attending club functions, helping when grade rostered on for teas, etc
