History

The Wanneroo Cricket Club (WCC) was founded in 1973 and since that time has won more than 33 premierships, including 15 A Grade Premierships (A Grade Premiers in 2014/15) in the North Suburban Community Cricket Association (NSCCA), previously the Wanneroo Cricket Association. In 2016/17 the Wanneroo Cricket Club was named the NSCCA's Champion Club and won the A Grade One Day Premiership. Last season we had more than 100 Senior playing members and this season will field five teams in the NSCCA league. The WCC also has over 240 Junior playing members and runs In2Cricket (4 to 7yo), T20 Blast (8 to 12yo) and U10 to U17 junior programs.

Home Grounds

The Wanneroo Cricket Club (WCC) and clubrooms are based at the Wanneroo Showgrounds. We run a licenced bar on Thursday and Saturday nights and generally have 50 or more players and associates attend the Saturday night presentations. Our other regular home grounds are Edgar Griffiths Reserve, Houghton Reserve and Scenic Drive.

Fees

In season 2017/18, we will trial **Pay As You Play** fees. There will be no upfront payment required with registration and ball fees being paid on a weekly basis – pay as you play. The weekly fee will be \$20 for standard members and \$15 for students, coaches, life members and sponsors. This weekly fee will cover your registration and ball fees.

Note that your weekly fee will be reduced from the standard fee where you:

- Coach a Wanneroo Junior Cricket Club side

Social Events

Apart from normal bar operations on Thursday and Saturday nights the club runs a number of social functions each season plus an end of season Awards dinner. A number of functions are planned for the 2017/18 season including the annual Quiz Night, City of Wanneroo Birds of Tokyo Concert, Ladies Day High Tea, Christmas Party, WCC Cricketers Cup, Cricketer of the Year and the Annual Season Wind-up.

The main criterion for selection is consistent performance on match day. Although this is the main criteria, other factors will be taken in to consideration such as:

- Spirit of the Game – How a player conducts himself on the field whilst representing the club.
- Training – Full training including fielding drills and fitness work twice a week for A and C Grades and at least once a week for other grades, however they are encouraged to train twice a week. Players must let their Captain or Selection Captain know in advance if they cannot make training.
